

Maintenance of Priasport R and Priasport DD sport floorings.

Initial cleaning

When sealed, initial cleaning of the sport floorings is carried out after joint-sealing. Remove any coarse dirt, using brushing devices, brushing machines, or by vacuum-cleaning. This must be followed by wet cleaning, with a recommended cleaning agent added to the water.

Give the flooring an initial cleaning with a single-disc cleaning machine using a red pad plus a suitable cleaning agent (see cleaning agent table).

Choose the correct mixing ratio, as specified by the cleaning agent.

Use a single-disc cleaning machine to distribute the cleaning solution. After allowing for a soaking period of about 15 minutes, clean intensively with the single-disc cleaning machine. Particular care must be taken to ensure the cleaning solution is not allowed to dry.

Mop up the dirty liquid with an aqua-vacuum-cleaner or an automatic cleaning machine.

Wipe again with clear water until all dirt and cleaning-agent residues have been removed from the floorcovering.

Initial polishing

Use a manual wipe method to evenly apply a suitable care/protection product (see table of cleaning agents) at increased concentration according to the manufacturer's instructions. Do not polish the protective film!

Routine cleaning

The floor should be kept clean by sweeping regularly with either a broom, a mechanical sweeper or a vacuum cleaner.

As and when necessary, the flooring should be washed with a neutral detergent. This can be carried out manually (small area) or mechanically (medium/large area) using a self-propelled mechanical scrubbing machine fixed with brushes. The surface should be carefully rinsed and vacuumed dry after washing.

Develop a regular cleaning programme suited to the usage and size of the area. Most sports surfaces are installed in larger areas and it is therefore important to use suitable mechanical cleaning equipment to provide a cost effective cleaning programme. Use only recommended cleaning liquids or their equivalent in correct concentration. Do not mix cleaning liquids and always follow the manufacturer's instructions.

Dirty equipment, particularly mops, does not clean but merely redistributes dirt.

Remove scuff marks regularly - because of the activities within a sports hall, all sports surfaces will show scuff marks from time to time. To remove them it may be necessary to concentrate the scrubbing with a stronger dilution of cleaner at these points. To help alleviate the problem we would recommend that in general, black soled sports shoes are not used in the sports area.

Whether daily or periodically cleaning should never be carried out when the sun is shining on the floor as this can cause staining to the surface of the material.

Maintenance of Prialpas floorings will be much easier if the program "Easy Clean" has been carried out on the surface (see next page).
